**Company's Status after the 2011 off the Pacific coast of Tohoku Earthquake**  
**(2<sup>nd</sup> notice)**

Tokyo Seimitsu (the Company) announces the Company's status as at March 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2011.

1. Employees

As previously announced, no injuries to directors, employees and their families have been confirmed.

2. Plants

Both the Hachioji Plant (Tokyo) and Tsuchiura Plant (Ibaraki Pref.) have no serious damage by fire or flood. Some minimal damage was sustained but this has not affected the plants which remained immediately operational. Although the Hachioji Plant is subject to the scheduled electricity blackouts occurring throughout the Tokyo region, the Company will maintain an equivalent operational manufacturing schedule and product shipment timetable through adjustments such as shift work.

3. Service to Customers

All business offices including in the stricken area such as the Tohoku Office (Wakabayashi-ku, Sendai-shi, Miyagi Pref.) had no serious damage to facilities (such as by fire or flood) and have been continuing operations. The Company is making direct contact with individual customers about product shipment, spare parts shipment, and service support schedules..

The Company expects that communication by Phone (Hachioji-Area) and E-mail might be occasionally delayed or interrupted, mainly because of Company's network shut-down by scheduled blackouts announced from Tokyo Electric Power Company, Inc.(The Hachioji Plant is defined as 2nd group of scheduled blackouts)

4. Suppliers

The Company has been continuously contacting and assessing the status of suppliers. Most of suppliers are operational, but a few are damaged. The Company will continue monitoring this.

5. Impact on business results for the Fiscal Year ending March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2011

The Company expects that the impact on the business results for the Fiscal Year ending March 31st, 2011 will be minimal. The Company will announce immediately any as yet unforeseen impacts to business results if information comes to hand.
